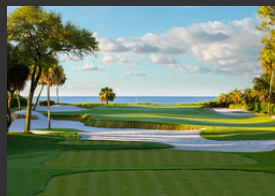

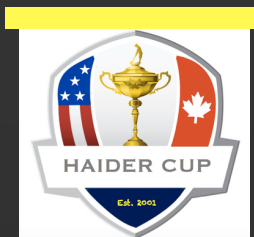
Atlantic Dunes
